

PRIVACY NOTICE

In accordance with Articles 13 and 14 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter "GDPR")

Dear Sir/Madame,

Pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of the GDPR, Chiesi Farmaceutici S.p.A. (hereinafter also "Chiesi") wishes to provide you with detailed information on how your personal data will be collected, managed and processed during the evaluation of the qualifications of scientific and medical Researchers who request the access to Chiesi clinical data. Therefore, we kindly ask you to carefully read the following Privacy Notice.

1) Data Controller

For purposes of this Privacy Notice the Data Controller is: Chiesi Farmaceutici S.p.A., via Palermo, 26/A 43122 Parma-Italy.

2) Purposes for the processing and consequences of failure to provide your data

Chiesi Farmaceutici S.p.A., which is the owner of the clinical trial data object of your request, will process your personal data as Data Controller in respect to its specific competence. The categories of personal data that Chiesi requests you include your name, current position, contact information (institution and department, address, city, state/province, post/zip code, country, phone, e-mail).

Chiesi wishes to inform you that providing the personal data mentioned above is mandatory in order to evaluate your qualification for conducting legitimate research using the clinical data provided by Chiesi. The refusal to give the requested consent to process your personal data will imply the exclusion from the evaluation process and consequently Chiesi will not consider your request.

3) Source and communication of personal data

The personal data, which will be processed for the purpose described above, will be collected by Chiesi and transmitted or otherwise made accessible to its employees/contractors, affiliates and third party service providers only with the information necessary to perform the services that we require.

Some of the above mentioned third parties may be established in countries outside the European Union that may not guarantee an adequate level of protection of personal data: in this case Chiesi has taken appropriate steps to ensure that the transfer complies with applicable national law implementing Article 44 of the GDPR.

Chiesi will not disclose your personal data to anybody else for any other reason unless we are required to do so by law. Chiesi takes commercially reasonable steps to secure and protect the personal data we collect from you and requires the same from any third-party vendor involved in this process. In the event of an incident or breach of your personal data, Chiesi will exercise commercially reasonable efforts to notify you to the extent required by your local law.

The updated list of third parties to whom your data has been communicated can be requested at any time to Chiesi as below specified in paragraph 5.

4) Procedure for the processing of personal data and legal grounds for the processing

The personal data you have provided or otherwise acquired by us within our activity:

- may be processed in hardcopy, by automated or electronic means in compliance with the applicable laws and regulations, with procedures strictly related to the purposes set out above and
- may involve all the operations provided for in Article 4 point 2 of the GDPR, including but not limited to collection, processing, storage, association, deletion, update.

Specific security measures are taken to prevent data loss, illegal or incorrect and unauthorized access and processing.

5) Data Protection Officer (DPO)

Chiesi Farmaceutici S.p.A., as Data Controller, has appointed a Data protection Officer pursuant to Article 37 of the GDPR who can be contacted at the email address dpoit@chiesi.com.

6) Data retention

Your personal data will be retained as necessary to perform the evaluation of your qualification for conducting legitimate research using the clinical data provided by Chiesi. In case of acceptance of your request, your personal data will be retained through the term of the applicable data sharing agreement and for a reasonable period thereafter for legitimate business purposes. In all circumstances, your personal data will be retained up to 10 years and will be promptly deleted or anonymized after the expiration of such term.

7) Data subjects rights

During any stage of personal data processing, you will be entitled to enforce, where applicable, the following rights:

1. right to access means the right to obtain from the Data Controller the knowledge whether your personal data is being processed and, where applicable, have access to it;
2. right to rectification and right to erasure means the right to obtain the rectification of inaccurate and/or incomplete personal data, as well as the erasure of personal data when the request is legitimate;
3. right to restriction of processing means the right to request suspension of the processing when the request is legitimate;
4. right to data portability means the right to obtain personal data in a structured format, ordinary used and readable, as well as the right to transfer personal data to other controllers;
5. right to object means the right to object to the processing of personal data when the request is legitimate, including when the personal data is processed for marketing or profiling, if applicable;
6. right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority in case of unlawful processing of personal data.

You can exercise the above-mentioned rights without formalities by writing to the Chiesi DPO (as above specified).

Your request will be processed without undue delay and in any case within 30 days of receipt of the request, except for more complex cases or due to a large amount of requests received, where said period may be extended by two further months.

You may withdraw your consent to processing your personal data at any time. In such case, Chiesi will not be able to proceed further with the next steps of the Data Sharing process.
